

From Little Langdale ford to High Hall Garth – U5003

When you walk from Little Langdale ford towards the Tilberthwaite track you pass two old farm houses that belong to the NT, Low Hall Garth and High Hall Garth. They are part of Beatrix Potter's legacy and now function as climbing huts. The track between them, enclosed by walls on both sides, is so narrow that 4x4s can't use it. Which doesn't mean they don't try.



This photo was taken in 2021, but the recklessness continues: below you can see the damage recently caused to one of the walls, themselves a valuable piece of heritage:



That this track should still be open to motor vehicles is difficult to believe. It's unsafe for walkers and cyclists and puts the fabric of the track at risk.
